### Inhambane Province

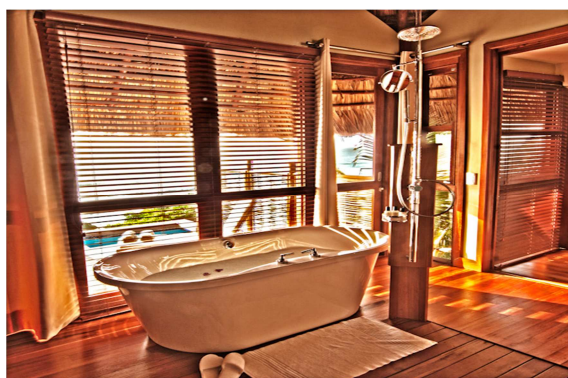
Mozambique's coastline is a haven of squeaky white beaches, rustling palms and many resorts and lodges to beckon holiday makers; the newest of these is Massinga Beach.

Whilst most upmarket resorts are located on the islands, here is one that is accessible by road and yet is near enough to Inhambane Airport to appeal to all modes of travel.

### **How to get there:**

Flights from Johannesburg or Maputo to Inhambane , send us an email on [info@mozambiquetourism.co.za](mailto:info@mozambiquetourism.co.za) for a fare, once you get to Inhambane the duration of the Transfer is 2 hours as guests have to be transferred around the Bay and up the EN1 ,to diminish the impact and add value the transfer includes:

Meet and greet at Inhambane Airport with refreshment

Vehicle Transfer to the harbour (+/- 10 mins)

Private authentic dhow ride across the Bay (+/- 20 mins depending on tides and shallow sand banks)

Mozambican finger-lunch on the other side in Maxixe (in the meantime the vehicle is driving around the Bay)

After lunch, a further 45 mins drive north across the Tropic of Capricorn – another highlight!

On the return journey guests are transferred all the way by road as they are now keen to see the countryside, culture and scenery.
